# Exhibitor Information

Category 1 Landscapers, nurseries and garden centres

Stands size: 5m x 5m \$150

Plant sales: you are welcome to sell from your stand, hire extra space inside the venue

or free space in the car park (first come, first serve basis)

Category 2 Garden/ lifestyle product suppliers

Stands size: 5m x 5m \$150

Category 3 The Market – local, homemade/ homegrown or crafted goods/ produce

Stands size: 3m x 3m \$100

Suppliers must declare on the application form the range of products/ produce they'd like to display and are asked to not bring additional products to TAGS without prior consent of

the show organizers.

Set-Up: Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> – Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> September

Please note that all stands must be setup by 1500 on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> September. At that time, all vehicles will be asked to leave the exhibition area and will not be allowed to re-enter on Saturday morning to fill your stand. If you would like to add display items to your stand on the Saturday morning you will need to carry those items on foot from the car park to your stand. Stands that contain high value items are welcome to post their own security guard, should they so wish.

Public times: Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> – Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> September

Packing-Up: Monday 19<sup>th</sup> September *before* 1200

- **Exhibition fees include** security, free entry for staff manning the stand and water for plants. No tents or other equipment is provided.
- **Note:** Exhibition fees are non-refundable deposits. The Annual Garden Show (TAGS), it's organizers and sponsors will not be held liable to refund such deposits or compensate for any other expenditure incurred by exhibitors in the event of TAGS being cancelled under any circumstances.
- There will be no mains power supply to stands. Features requiring power can be serviced by your own inverter, battery power or solar pumps/ lights. No generators will be permitted.
- You may request to hire more than one stand if you would like to take a larger space than 5m x 5m. However, space is limited and although we will endeavor to meet all requests we do not guarantee they will be granted.
- You may sell product/s directly from the stand.
- There are no restrictions on how much signage to choose to include in your allocated stand. If you would like to display additional signage at the show, an additional sponsorship fee will be charged. If you would like your brand to have optimal visibility in the run up to the event and at the show itself please contact us and we will send you the sponsorship pack.
- **Restrictions:** The display or sale of chemical fertilizers, pesticides or herbicides is prohibited at TAGS.
- Prohibited: the use in your display or the sale of any plants that are classified as Alien Invasive
